- Receipt of bids Professionals Mayor Barbera reviewed submissions of the professionals, noting that no indication of a need for change has been raised, and unless there was something to discuss the same professionals will be recommended for appointment in 2021 at the Reorganization meeting. Proposals can be provided to Council in total via email to assist review if requested.
- From NJDOT awarding 2021 Road Project Trenton & Virginia Mayor Barbera reviewed the award letter in the amount of \$174,930.

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- To NJDOT combining project Borough Administrator Cheeseman said that he had received word that the 2019
  and 2020 programs will be allowed to be combined as the 2019 was delayed. It may be a bit of a squeeze to get
  the additional work completed. It will be Hemlock, Madison, West Atlantic, and the bottoms of Sycamore and
  Glen to all be combined in one bid package. Confirmation of approval to combine should be received in a couple
  of weeks.
- From NJSAGE acknowledging receipt of West Atlantic Enhancement Grant Application It was noted that the automated Grant receipt has been received. There was discussion of when the Borough would receive word of award or decline, which is not known and that it would be sweet to get it and the NJDOT road project all together.
