AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LAUREL SPRINGS CREATING A NEW CHAPTER ENTITLED, "WILDLIFE FEEDING"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAUREL SPRINGS, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Purpose: An ordinance to prohibit the feeding of unconfined wildlife in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by the Borough of Laurel Springs, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply

SECTION 2. Definitions: For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this Chapter clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- A. Feed to give, place, expose, deposit, distribute or scatter any edible material with the intention of feeding, attracting or enticing wildlife. Feeding does not include baiting in the legal taking of fish and/or game.
- Person any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.
- C. Wildlife all animals that are not domesticated.

SECTION 3. Prohibited Conduct:

A. No person shall feed, in any public park or on any public street or any other property owned or operated by the Borough of Laurel Springs, any wildlife, excluding confined wildlife, such as wildlife confined in rehabilitation centers or environmental education centers.

SECTION 4. Enforcement: This ordinance shall be enforced by the Police

Department and/or other Municipal Officials of the Borough of Laurel Springs.

SECTION 5. Penalties: Any person, entity or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, before the Municipal Court of the Borough of Laurel Springs, be subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both, in
