- Tree Lighting and WinterFEST – Councilman DelPidio said that he was able to lock in singers. Santa will arrive in the carriage. Fire Department will be met with Chief Cheeseman. Friday, November 25th and Saturday, November 26th will be the days for decorating downtown. There are more volunteers engaged. The Makers Workshop has the vendor situation in hand. There was discussion of crowd control, horse and carriage and vendors. Last years' IAP, JIF Event Form, street closing letter, and program were given for review and update. The Newsletter was ready for printing and reviewed.
